Career Technical Education Delivers

According to a 2010 Ohio Department of Education Ohio School Funding Advisory Report:

- 94.6% of high school Career Technical Education students graduate
- 53% of all CTE students enroll in postsecondary or advanced training, compared to 45% for traditional students
- Ohio CTE students outperform students in other states by 22% in reading, 19% in science, and 9% in mathematics
- CTE students are better prepared for college – just 39% of CTE students entering Ohio's community colleges needed to make up academic ground in remediation courses as opposed to 49% of traditional students. CTE students progress faster to their degrees and/or certifications and enter the workforce at a faster rate

Career Technical Education is a Smart Investment:

- Our high school students enter the job market with credentials making good wages or go on to college
- The CTC provides multiple education pathways that emphasize high quality career and college readiness



Ohio's First Career Technology Center - Since 1967, more than 14,000 Clark County students have passed through the doors of the Springfield-Clark Career Technology Center (formerly the Springfield-Clark County Joint Vocational School) campus. There are eight buildings on campus that house 25 career technical programs for high school students.



Ohio is one of two states in the nation with a comprehensive CTE system. It was established in the 1940s and today, with a highly advanced 21st Century curriculum, enables high school students to obtain highly technical and specialized skills.

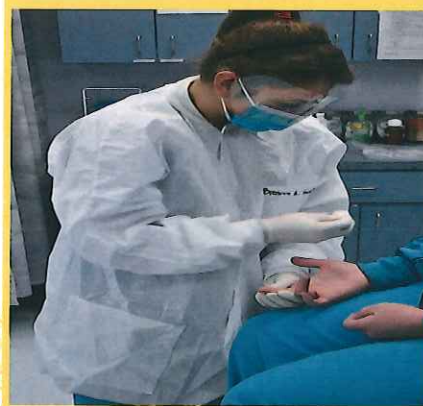
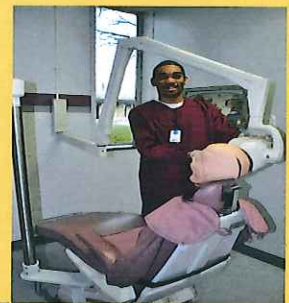
